Team A donated their time to organize the Downtown Fremont Christmas Parade in November, 2008. They did a wonderful job and received many

compliments on how smoothly it ran.

Team B held two Texas Hold'Em Tournaments to raise money for First Step, a family violence shelter that serves Sandusky County. They raised nearly \$1,000 to help the organization build a much needed fence on their property. They also plan to hold a bake sale to supplement their donation.

Youth Leadership Sandusky County Class of 2009

The Youth Leadership class has participated in 3 sessions so far this year. The most recent session took place at Journey's Family Amusement Center. Topics discussed included Employee/Employer Relationships, Business Community Involvement, Customer Service, and Entrepreneurship.

They heard from several area business people including Carol Guice from The Job Store, Henri Martin from Wal-Mart, and Robert Carter from

Journey's Family Amusement Center.

Some time during this session was set aside for the teams to work on their community service project. One team has decided to benefit the Humane Society through a car wash fund raiser.

The other team decided to benefit a local family through WSOS by purchasing beds for the children of the family. They held two bake sales in local stores and raised over \$700, well over their goal of \$500.

Class members are also required to complete community service hours separate from their projects. Each class member must also do individual presentations based on their team projects at the graduation ceremony in order to complete the program.

There is one class sessions remaining this year to be held on April 13th. Graduation will take place in May at Terra state Community College.

Attention Parents of 7th Grade Students...

Now is the time to be contacting your child's guidance counselor about being a part of the 2010 Youth Leadership Sandusky County Class.

Youth LSC is open to 8th grade students who attend a school who's district is at least partially located in Sandusky County.

The class starts with an orientation,

held during an evening in September, and then meets in October, December, February, and April followed by a graduation breakfast in May.

Classes start at 8:30 a.m. and run to 2:00 p.m. and typically take place on a day where most schools are not in session, such as Columbus Day, Christmas Break, and Presidents Day. This is done to prevent

excessive absences at school. In the case that your child does have to miss school to attend YLSC, he or she will be excused but expected to make up their missed work.

The Mission of Leadership Sandusky County

To provide a learning experience that encourages successful community leadership

Leadership Sandusky County (LSC) is a non-profit organization that was founded in 1991. LSC is committed to developing potential leaders and enhancing the skills and knowledge of current leaders interested in improving their communities.

LSC offers yearly professional leadership courses. Participants meet one day per month from September to May and participate in various learning experiences. Several topics covered are boardmanship, agriculture, marketing, economic development, manufacturing, and education.

Those selected for the course also learn

to identify and develop teambuilding and leadership skills through interactive presentations and participation in team projects. Each team is responsible for looking at needs in the county and developing and implementing a plan to carry out a community service project.

Participants are provided with opportunities to meet and network with other leaders in the county. During a guided bus tour of the county, they meet mayors and city officials and learn how the individual communities function. Participants also meet business, health, government, and non-profit leaders during presentations and at social events such as a Wine and Cheese Reception, and Holiday Reception cosponsored by the Chamber of Commerce of Sandusky County, and at the LSC Graduation Banquet.

Classes are held at different locations throughout the county to provide exposure to the various sectors of the county. Locations include Whirlpool, Terra Community College, Memorial Hospital, Sandusky County Department of Job & Family Services, and more.

Youth leadership development courses are also offered to students attending each of the junior high schools in the County. These classes are modeled after the adult course.

In addition, LSC offers on-going support, education, and networking opportunities to its leadership graduates through its alumni association. Members of the alumni association are invited to graduation and social events held throughout the year.
